Speech and Language

A Speech and Language Therapist has joined our school. Sarah Swann will be at the school once a week (Monday mornings 9am-12pm).

Speech and Language Therapists work with children with all types of Speech, Language and Communication Needs, including Autism, Specific Language Impairment and Learning Difficulties. They use a range of techniques and strategies, and provide advice and support for parents and school staff about how to use them. Sarah has begun observing school lessons and will be working with staff, to increase awareness of SLCN, support effective communication skills and create communication friendly classrooms. She may also run language and communication groups and 1:1 sessions, and support school staff to run groups and sessions targeted to the needs of specific children.

If we feel it is appropriate to involve Sarah more directly in the assessment and management of your child, we will contact you to discuss this and you will be asked for consent for this contact to begin.

Parking Outside School
